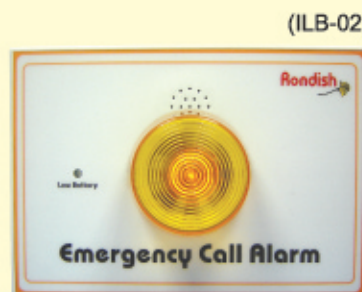
Emergency assistance alarm provided in a toilet for disabled people

- A wireless call system to gain immediate help in an emergency, designed to meet the worldwide need and desire to better serve disabled people.
- Complies with regulations devised to ensure barrier free entry and use of public facilities by the disabled.
- Being wireless, it is much easier and quicker to install than wired versions, and therefore less labor intensive and more economic.
- It has applications in all kinds of public and commercial buildings, including hospitals, elderly homes, schools, universities, factories, offices, restaurants, hotels, shops, etc.
- The alarm is distinctive in appearance and sound, so it cannot be confused with fire alarms, and is specifically for the disabled person to gain help in an emergency.
- The 3 basic wireless system components are :
 1. a waterproof call button with pull cord (WCP-02) reachable from the toilet or floor. (wall or ceiling mounted)
 2. a waterproof reset button (WRE-02) to cancel alarm after rescue. (wall mounted, near pull cord)
 3. an emergency call alarm (ILB-02) located outside the room (wall or ceiling), to ensure emergency action is taken by passers-by to help the disabled person in duress.
- Since all components are wireless, the supplied batteries are long lived, and last over 5 or, with little use, up to 10 years. All components have low battery alert, with an assurance LED which blinks slowly when the "low battery" condition occurs.
- Many toilets with digital wireless call buttons, programmed with different numbers by area, may be monitored centrally from an office or guard room using our Central Monitor (CMU-02). The low battery condition of any of the alarm components are also observed from the central station, so they may be replaced as well as auto check make sure all buttons are operational.

Standard Features

- The ultra thin (18mm) Emergency Call unit fits standard BS back box or is simply screwed on the wall and has an orange design, with a cord, 3m in length with plastic handles. It has an LED which lights when alarm has been activated, providing an indication that assistance is on its way to reassure those in distress. This unit also has a push button which may be optionally used if installed at a height to be reachable by disabled users. Emergency call alarm is easily programmed the using a self learn button.
- The Reset unit fits standard BS back box and has a green design, with a green button to reset. It may also be used to reset if the emergency pull cord is activated accidentally and is located to be reachable from both a wheelchair and the WC.
- The Emergency Call Alarm unit located outside usually above the door is easily seen and heard, with an orange indicator light and a buzzer sound distinct from fire alarms. The unit clearly indicates where help is required. If desired, another call alarm unit may be sited remotely. Best of all, a Central Monitor may be used to monitor many toilets at the same time, from an office or guard room, ensuring that assistance is timely by someone capable of responding professionally to an emergency. When used with the Central Monitor, the buttons are fully supervised to detect any failure.
- All units are user programmable and easy to replace. All units have hygienic and washable front panels so they may be easily wiped during normal WC cleaning. Easy, auto-learn, read-in function on emergency call alarm. (up to 5 buttons)
